
## John Stinson's Reel


A line OVER the L or R means, play on left treble side. NO LINE means, right treble side. A line UNDER the L or R means, play on BASS bridge.















I've played this tune in jam sesions from California to North Carolina, and back to Texas. I've played it with Irish musicians in Ireland! It sound a lot like "Leather Britches" which is popular in Western North Carolina and East Tennessee. I think John Stinson was actually an Irish musician.
